Dear Sir:

Your letter of the 5th inst. Just received.

Replying to same, I was indeed glad that you could go on the hunting trip. Now please understand that this hunting party is as much your partie as it is any of the ones that go.

Not having a copy of my letter I wrote to you when I sent you the copie of the contract ect, I can't remember if I told you that if four did not make the trip the cost to us to Baxter, would be sixty hundred dollars, and if two went it would be \$4700.00; dollars. Mr. Graham, the other man here at Riverton, besides my self that is going on the trip, we two are going if not others go and the cost to us then would be \$4700.00; then if you will go it will cost for us three, sixty hundred dollars to Baxter, as stated above. What I am driving at is I want you to fully undrestand just what it will cost if only three of us go, of course you understand that it will cost each of us the same amount, for the trip.

Now if we can still find the fourth man in the next few days we can take a party of four and it will then cost each a little less, however, if you are will to take the trip with just three we will not take the fourth man.

Now if you will still go send your Draft for \$500.00; made payable to Charles H. Baxter, White Horse, Yukon Territory, Canada. If you prefere to you may send it to the First State Bank of Riverton, made payable as stated, with instructions for them to send it to paxter but if you will send it to me and I will then send it on to Baxter, and send you a contract showing you have made your deposit of \$500; and that you are a member of the party of three to the or for the hunting trip this season, with our party of three with Charles H. paxter, who is to take us into the Yukon & Alaska, hunting country of the White River Section, to be gone on a trip from White Horse, Yukon, for Fifty days on a hunting trip.

Mr. Graham is a man of a bout 38 year old a man near your size and weight. My self I am 32 about 5-8 inches and weight a bout 140 pounds.

Upon receipt of your draft will make out a complete list of what I will take along on the trip. Would now only it will take a good bit to give you a full list as I want to give it to you complete.
