Struble of Fredericktown Ohio on Fall Hunting trip we had very bad weather while on trip but we had fine luck geting trophies we got Four Sheep 4 Caribou 3 Moose, and 7 Grizzley, s on trip Mr. Struble get 2 Sheep 2 Caribou 2 Moose 2 Bear. Mrs Struble get 2 Sheep 2 Caribou. I Moose and 5 Grizzley, s she was the greatest weman that i ever seen in the Mts she had most Men skined a city Block geting around and Shooting she was a Crackerjack and a good Fellow beside. Mr Struble was also a fine Man. in Feb or March issue of Outdoor Life will be a Regeter publisher simlair to that of the Cassiar, of all the Hunting party, a that Hunted in Yukon the past season with all Trophies killed by each party and measurements of Trophies and the Name, s of Guide, s that was with each party so you can see for your self who got there party, s the came and you will also see that Mrs Struble get the Largest Moose Killed by any Hunter that Hunted in this Territory the past season, and the Struble party got almost as many Bear as all the other party, s togher did. as you know Bill that your uncle Dud--ley can get them the Bear where other Guide, s could not find a Bear, s Track. i had Is Herse, s en trip a cook Micky McCarthy by Name who was a Dam poor cook and Two indians Bobby kane and Jake Fred were indians Names both good indians i have not had Johnie Frazer on a trip since you were up here Johnie did not have enough hussle in him to suite me he has wanted work with me ever summer but i did not need him, you know Bill that the Came Law.s were changed againe last spring the Hunting Licenes are back to \$100. agains and Hunter can kill and export on his Licenes I Sheep I Goat I Meose and 2 Caribou and no Restrictions on Bear, but if a Hunter wants more Trophies he can kill 2 more Sheep 2 Goat 2 Caribou and I Moose by paying \$25.00, per Head, so i think this a very good Game Law and it seemed to meet with the approvial of all the Hunter, s that was in here the past seasen.

i, am allredy Booked for the comeing season have one party from New Zealand with three in party another of Two from Decatur ILL. and may have Mr Henry Bannon of Pertsmouth Ohio and Goo S Briggs of Santa Anna Cal. for spring Bear Hunt so you can see Bill that thing are Busy for me in my line of Buisness.

we are haveing another fine winter up in this part of the world not much Snew on the Ground and we have had very little cold weather up to Date. the Horse, s are all Hog Fat i have only lost Two Horse, s since you were up here Big Buck is just as Fat and slick, as a mole little Buck is fine i have I2 head of Horse, s turned out with 10 mile, s of town i, am going down tomorrow to bring up the Little B lack Nigger Mair that Pat Rode on

Bill we are mighty glad to here of your Marrage and all we can hope is that all of your trouble, swill be Little, s One, s we would send you some little Gift but the Duty would be more than what it would be worth so will waite untill we are out side and the first Sen that is Bern we will give him the present enstead of you. Ha.Ha.
