Dear Friend Bill

I thought I answer your welcome letter
I was sure glad to hear from you I often thought
there might be something wrong But glad to know
your & Mr. and family well about myself I
am O.K as usual only once in a while I get
Rheumatism in my Right Shoulder But when it
get Right Bad I give it some Christian Since I
get me a hammer and some Drills and
start pounding a hole in some Rock or some
of that sort and it Barnishes away Perhaps it
don't like work

Well I am still Pounding away at our property
But has not made a deal for it for so fore yet
we are trying to open it up in order that
we can command a better price you know it costs
like the Dickens If I had the means I would
open it up myself and work it however
I can sit down and take a mortar and make
good wages we have Rock that goes about
~~about~~ twenty two hundred Dollars to the ton and you
know it don't take much to make a ton of this
sort of stuff

Do you know if Pat Flaherty is in Mason City yet -
he is a kind of a promoter I would make him
a good offer if I could come in contact with
him I would give him an interest with us
if he could organize a co and where we could
raise money to go ahead with development In
other words he could send an expert to look
at the situation first of all so as to know for himself
that the property is as I represent it I being
thinking of going out myself and try and raise
some money so as we could put in some machinery
If you know of his whereabouts drop him a line
or mail him this letter after you are through
and perhaps he might be interested
Well Old Fall you can rest assure I will call
on you when I go outside I wish I was there
now It is about 40 Below now But got lots of good
wood and such you meat and grub so let
her Buck We also have a phone we got permission
from the government to get one it connected on
to the Telegraph line running from Valdez to
Fairbanks its operated by the Signal Corp
we got soldiers 12 miles on each side of us

So we get the latest Dope that comes over the
wire our nearest neighbour is about 6 miles from
us so you see we are not crowded for Room
and goats above our lower Camp I killed 7 in one
setting this fall we also got some sheep and some
I believe I would prefer a fine
spat about I killed a mess of
I am writing this But I don't
know just when I will get to mail it I will have to
snow shoe into Valdez about New year that 48 miles
from us Peoples back there would tick like the
Dickens if they had to go that fare after mail and through
the same conditions and a high summer to go over
no trail broken But I make it Well I am
sending you a few Pictures I will be delighted
to have a picture of you and family I often look at
yours and the Mrs on the Boat coming from the Hawaiian
Isles Well Old Boy I wish you and family a
Happy Xmas and a prosperous New year and
best of luck hoping to hear from you again
